

Terms and conditions

The tenant will take possession of the chalet and its contents, for time between the dates marked on the contract. Under no circumstance does the tenant have the right to stay in the chalet before or after the agreed dates marked in the contract. This agreement is only for the named person in the contract unless the landlord is consulted and an agreement is arranged.

The tenant must inform the landlord if any item in the chalet is not working correctly. The tenant is required to respect the chalet, and its environment, no subletting will be tolerated.

The number of tenants must not exceed 4 people otherwise the landlord reserves the right to cancel the contract.

No pets are allowed.

For security reasons it is forbidden to smoke in the chalet.

The reservation will be confirmed the moment the tenant returns a signed copy of the contract and half the agreed fee marked in the contract.

The total fee should be paid on the day of entry into the chalet along with the full deposit. This will be returned the week after the tenants departure if all is found to be in order.

Cancellation

All cancellations must be confirmed in writing.

The deposit will be returned only if the chalet can be rented again.

If the tenant does not arrive or inform the landlord of any changes in the 24 hours after the arrival date the landlord reserves the right to keep the deposit.

At the beginning and at the end of the rental period the tenant and the landlord will complete a full inventory of the chalet and its belongings.

The chalet is equipped with furniture, bedding and crockery as described in the list. The tenant is responsible for all objects on the inventory and will be required to reimburse or replace any broken or damaged items. The tenant must inform the landlord of any breakages or damage in the chalet. The tenant must return the chalet to the landlord in the same condition as when the said tenant entered the chalet. The tenant must have insurance to cover all possible damage that may arise during the tenants stay.
